

A sample plan to discuss before you travel

Illustrative planning worksheet — not a patient case, hospital quotation, appointment or medical recommendation. Use it to organise questions; it does not promise an individual plan within 24 hours.

Your questions and practical constraints

Care you are exploring: to discuss. Country of residence and travel window: to discuss. Questions for the treating team: to discuss. Clinical suitability: hospital assessment required.

Hospital and appointment

Hospital, department and proposed team: not yet selected. Official information and confirmation contact: to obtain. Appointment and required records: not confirmed. A directory listing is not a booking.

Illustrative fee calculation

If medical expenses were USD 10,000 and the agreed fixed service fee were USD 300, a 10–25% fee would be USD 1,000–2,500. Medical expenses plus MedicCN fees would total USD 11,300–12,800 BEFORE flights, accommodation, meals, insurance and additional agreed services or return visits. These are invented inputs to explain arithmetic, not prices for a procedure.

What the fees cover

The fixed USD 200–500 service fee includes visa fees, airport and hotel transfers and 24-hour mobile Wi-Fi. The 10–25% medical-expense fee covers partner-channel coordination and professional bilingual accompaniment. The rate depends on treatment type and accompaniment level. Confirm the rate, calculation basis and scope in your written quote.

Dates, follow-up and payment

Assessment, treatment, review and return-travel guidance: hospital confirmation required. Records, clinical contact and follow-up at home: to arrange. Contracting entity, payee, payment dates and cancellation terms: obtain in writing before paying. Unconfirmed costs are not zero.

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
